RENEGADES/TORPEDOES INVITATIONAL Dec. 3-4, 2011

This event will start 4 p.m. Saturday afternoon and finish by 9 p.m. Sunday.

Location; Talisman Centre, Calgary

Tournament Fee; Fees are set for \$60 per team. Fees and registration deadline are due by **Dec 1, 2011**. Clubs are to make cheques payable to Renegades WP Club and mail to 2225 Macleod Trail SE Calgary AB. T2G-5B6

Team Information;

There will be a tournament representative at the pool; throughout the event should you have any questions. Please ensure that you use professionalism when speaking to the rep, anger and hostility will NOT be tolerated.

Technical Information: FINA rules will be followed with the following exceptions

- Once all the teams are registered we will send out the game minute times per age group
- U16 teams -25 meter pool/ U18 - girls 25 meter pool/ U18 male will play 25 meter pool
- Male Sr and Open will play 25 meter pool
- Female Sr and Open will play 25 meter pool
- Tie games- will be left at that score
- 2 time outs per game
- Players can be entered into 2 age group categories, but please ensure that there are a minimum of seven players in each age category to field a team. There must be 7 players at the start of the game, no delays will be accepted.

Players can not be on 2 rosters in the same age category

Registration for the Tournament: All teams and players must be a 'member in good standing' with their National organization and proof will need to be provided at the start of the technical meeting. This year all registrations/entries of teams to the event and rosters will be done through the Water Polo Canada database under the events tab. registering your team and athletes names on rosters on-line serves as proof of good

standing with WPC. All information is also there with deadlines, team sizes and rosters. This must be done this way NO other forms of registration will be accepted. When entering the rosters, please make sure that they are the correct cap numbers, as this is what will be printed on game sheets. You must also include your coaches that will be on deck with the team and chaperone on the roster, they will also receive a pass to get onto the deck.

NO ATHLETE WILL BE ALLOWED ONTO A ROSTER AT THE EVENT UNLESS THERE IS PROOF OF REGISTRATION WITH THEIR PROVINCIAL BODY.

Protest Format: \$100 cash is required for any protest. The deposit will be reimbursed if the decision is in favor of your protest. All protests must be made in writing and within 30 minutes from the time of the end of the game. A protest must be signed by the head coach. The protest committee shall be comprised of 3 senior people from each pool, a referee, the tourney pool coordinator and another selection.

Important Reminders

- Warm up for the subsequent games begins immediately following the end of the previous game. You will not be allowed to use any other pools of the Talisman Center only the ones that we have booked that are games being played in.
- For each game, coaches need to check the cap numbers/names listed on the score sheet to ensure their accuracy.

Parents are not allowed on deck, they are to be in the stands watching the games. Unless they are minor officiating and found on deck they will be asked to go upstairs.
