in an epic Pan Am Games final

Former Calgary Renegade Emily Csikos scored five goals in regulation and another four in a four-round shootout before Canada finally fell to the United States in the gold-medal final of the Pan Am Games at Guadalajara, Mexico last Friday. The loss means Canada will have to play for a berth in the 2012 Olympics at a qualifying event next spring.

Canada led the U.S. 7-3 midway through the third quarter before the Americans began a comeback which saw them tie the game 8-8 with 31 seconds to play. The teams played two scoreless overtime periods, before the heart-stopping shootout. Each team ended up taking 20 shots before the Americans prevailed 19-18 in a game that will be talked about for years to come.
